Santa Cruz City School District's "Kids EXPLORE After School" in partnership with the Delaveaga's PTC and Santa Cruz Education Foundation is excited to be offering classes this Fall!

The goal of the program is to provide all children the opportunity to participate in high quality after-school enrichment classes. The actual cost for each student is between \$80-\$150 for an 8-week session. Registration forms provide an option for parents to: contribute funds to cover the actual cost; provide partial payment if needed or support a scholarship for another student. We sincerely appreciate any contributions toward our actual cost as this will help us expand the program for future sessions.

We also understand that "First Come - First Served" registration is difficult for some parents. Therefore we are coordinating a DROP OFF registration option. 20% of the total spaces available per class will be randomly chosen from the DROP OFF registration forms.
