

2019-2020 Schedule Pick-Up Day Wednesday, August 14th, 2019

Harbor High's Schedule Pick-Up Day is when students pick up their schedules, get their textbooks, get their pictures taken for their school ID and yearbook, sign up for fall sports and reunite with their schoolmates.

Schedule Pick-Up Day by Grade Level and Time:

8:00 am – 9:30 am: 9th Grade 11:00 am – 12:30 pm: 11th Grade

9:30 am – 11:00 am: 10th Grade 12:30 pm – 1:30 pm: 12th Grade

What does student need to do before Schedule Pick-Up Day?

In order for student to receive a copy of their schedule, parents must complete all required summer mailer forms through the Illuminate Parent Portal.

What does student need to bring?

- Overdue or outstanding text and library books
- Completed Application for Free and Reduce Price Meals: Even if student does not qualify or believe that the student will not eat lunch at school, Harbor High can qualify for additional funds if parents complete the form.

What if student cannot attend?

If student cannot attend the event, a parent or guardian who completed required paperwork through their Illuminate Parent Portal can pick-up student's schedule. All students who have not yet picked up their schedule by the first day of school may do so that morning in front of the Counseling Office. The library will be open Monday, August 19th and Tuesday, August 20th from 9am-12pm for book returns.

What if there is an error on student's schedule?

Student may complete a schedule correction request form in situations where there is an error in their schedule that affects their graduation status, does not reflect a completed summer course, shows an incomplete schedule or places the student in the wrong level of a course. Correction forms will be available to turn into the counseling office. If student completed a summer course, please bring the grade report to attach it to the schedule correction request.
