Soquel High School Cell Phone Policy Cell Phone Violation: Education Code (E.C. 51512)

Cell phones and headphones/earbuds* must be put away during class hours, including time out of the classroom on a hall pass, and during <u>ALL</u> school and state tests. <u>Students will not be allowed to use cell phones during class time, except with teacher permission.</u>

School authorities may confiscate cell phones at any time for failure to follow school policy. (Teachers, please call '311' if student is refusing to give up phone.)

<u>First Offense</u>: Verbal warning is given to the entire class as part of the initial class policies or on an individual basis.

<u>Second Offense</u>: Phone is confiscated and sent to the office. Phone must be collected from administration by a parent/guardian. Administrator will document in Illuminate.

<u>Third Offense</u>: Phone is confiscated and sent to the office. Phone must be collected from administration by a parent/guardian, and student will be assigned a detention. Administrator will document in Illuminate.

<u>Fourth Offense</u>: Phone is confiscated and sent to the office. Administration and parent/guardian will agree on a plan for student to turn in phone to the office daily. Administrator will document in Illuminate.
