STUDENT:

I understand and will abide by the <u>Student Technology and Online Acceptable Use Guidelines and the policies in the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook.</u>

PARENT/GUARDIAN:

I understand that Chromebook access is designed for educational purposes. I recognize it is impossible for SCCS to restrict access to all controversial materials and I will not hold SCCS responsible for materials acquired on the network. Further, I accept full responsibility for supervision when my child's use is not in a school setting. I hereby give permission to issue a device intended for my child and certify that the information contained on this form is correct.

BOTH STUDENT & PARENT/GUARDIAN: Damage/Repairs: If a Chromebook is damaged beyond repair and needs to be replaced, SCCS will evaluate replacement options on a case by case basis. A student may be held responsible for some or all of the replacement costs and possible disciplinary action. The cost per Chromebook and power adapter is \$250.00.

Theft/Vandalism/Fire: In cases of issues due to theft, vandalism, fire and other criminal acts; parents/guardians should report the incident to their school administration.

Student Pledge for Chromebook Use:

- 1. I will take care of my Chromebook by protecting it from extreme hot and cold temperatures, keeping food and beverages away from it.
- 2. I agree to the terms and conditions of the Student Technology and Online Acceptable Use Guidelines and the policies in the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook.
- 3. I will be the primary user of the Chromebook and never loan it to other individuals.
- 4. I will never leave my Chromebook unattended in an unsecured location.
- 5. If my Chromebook is not working properly, I will email itdept@sccs.net. I will not attempt any repairs on my own or through someone other than the SCCS-IT department.
- 6. I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the SCCS Chromebook.
- 7. I understand that damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse will be reviewed on a case by case basis. As with the assignment of textbooks, I could be held partially or fully responsible for damages/loss.
- 8. If a Chromebook has been checked out to me in quarantine, I will return it upon return to school.
