## 20-1112.04 <u>Classroom Modernization (CASEWORK OPTIONS)</u>

Option 1: Double Cabinet with Drawers (with Mobile Bookcase)

Cost: \$35,596

**Option 2**: Single Cabinet, 4 Wide Drawers, 2 Drawers (with Mobile Bookcase)

Cost: \$39,184

Option 3: 2 Double Cabinets, 2 Drawers (No Mobile Bookcase)

**Cost:** \$39,670 \*Last cabinet on new casework would possibly block existing drawers on some casework; varies based on room. It is possible to remove this last cabinet on new casework to allow for this drawer to remain operable.

#### \*\* Committee voted for OPTION 3

MADI 19six team will proceed with having the contractor install option 3

#### **Comments on Casework Options:**

- -Would like to keep kids from going up against window, (Option 3) prevents students from accessing this area for safety purposes.
- -Do not want to lose existing functionality of existing casework.
- -(Option 3) Provides the most storage out of all the options; hidden cabinetry and drawers are more versatile than bookshelves.
- -(Option 3) Best option due to the counterspace and aesthetic purposes.
- -(Option 3) Replaces what was already existing without taking any away

## 20-1112.05 Playground & Shade Structures:

Proposed Playground Modernizations: 1 Full Sized Basketball Court to Replace Existing, 1 Ball Wall, 2 Shade Structures, and Striping.

## Committee Approved to proceed with two shade structures & locations shown on presentation (\$220,000 Budget)

\*No contentions on location of proposed Shade Structures.

## 20-1112.06 Additional Projects/Items & Comments:

### **Kinder Shed:**

- -Want to maintain Kinder Orchard Area.
- -Need to prioritize Kinder Shed Replacement; they lost their shed and therefore lost a lot of storage. Kinder did not get anything out of the modernization.

#### Ball Wall:

- \*Ball Wall cannot be too central in play area due to the fact that central area is a fire lane.
- -Are there other options for Ball Wall location? \*Do not want to place Ball Wall too close to classrooms but feels awkwardly placed in current layout option.
- -Worried about competing balls ricocheting into basketball court.
- -Will traffic flow be an issue in case of emergency with current ball wall location?
- -Advocating for not putting Tether Ball Courts back up (rarely used and take up space); possibly adding a pull up bar for the older kids.
- -If we wait for Ball Wall installation can we add it later where portables will be demoed in the future? Yes, the ball wall can be tabled for another time/discussion. Are portables 100% set to be demoed? No, waiting on direction from the District on how to proceed with classroom spaces due to COVID-19
- -In current layout, Balls will hit kids on play structure and becomes an issue.
