## **RECOMMENDATION**:

Approve overnight field trip for the Soquel High School Varsity Football Team and Cheer Squad to attend the CIF State Championship Bowl game scheduled for Friday, December 8, 2023.

### **BACKGROUND**:

The Soquel Football program, under the direction of Head Coach Dwight Lowery has achieved a record of 12 Wins and 2 Losses during the 2023-2024 Football Season. Soquel earned the school's first Central Coast Section Title and the Northern California Regional Champions Title for the first time in school history. On Friday, December 8, 20023 at 8 pm, the team will participate in the State Championship game in Pasadena.

The Soquel High School Cheer program has been an essential component of school climate and culture, and has exponentially grown in the three years since being supervised by Head Coach Cory Montanez. The Cheer squad will accompany the football team to the Championship game.

The Soquel Varsity Football team, 50 students, will depart Soquel High School on a chartered bus at 9:00 am Thursday 12.08.23 and will return to Soquel High on Saturday 12.09.23 at 5:00 pm. The football team will miss two days of classes. Ten coaches will accompany the Football team and serve as chaperones.

The Football team (50 Student Athletes and 10 Coaches) will stay at the Hilton Pasadena 168 S. Los Robles Ave. Pasadena Ca. 91100 for two nights.

The Soquel Cheer Squad (20 Students and 5 Chaperones) will be traveling to support the program, departing on a separate charter Friday 12.08.23 at 8:00 am and returning Saturday 12.09.23 at 5:00 pm. with 5 chaperones. The Cheer Squad will miss one day of classes.

The Cheer Squad also plans to stay at the Hilton Pasadena.

The Principal and four other staff chaperones will join the team on Friday for the game and stay at the Hilton with the team and cheer squad.

The California Interscholastic Federation provides financial support for all teams reaching the level of Championship Bowl. However, the percentage of reimbursement is insufficient, and will require site and booster club supplemental assistance in the areas of transportation. The Cheer Squad will fundraise to cover the costs of their transportation and lodging.

This item is coming for approval through a special meeting, as information on travel was not available until after the Board Book for the study session on December 6th was published.
